Topic: « The impact of pharmaceutical innovation and access on hospitalization, disability, and mortality : international evidence »

Biography:

Frank R. Lichtenberg is Courtney C. Brown Professor of Business at the Columbia University Graduate School of Business; a Research Associate of the National Bureau of Economic Research; and a member of the CESifo Research Network. Some of Professor Lichtenberg's research has examined how the introduction of new technology arising from research and development affects the productivity of companies, industries and nations.

During his seminar, Professor Lichtenberg will present some of his empirical results on the role played by new drug launches and access to prescription drugs in reducing hospitalization, disability, and mortality.
